

## **Core Cutter – Short Term – Vizsla Copper Corp**

### **Job description:**

Vizsla Copper Corp. is seeking motivated individuals to join our exploration team as Core Cutters for ongoing field programs. The successful candidate will assist in the processing and sampling of diamond drill core and perform general labour tasks to support exploration activities.

### **About the Role:**

This is a field-based position operating on a rotational schedule in a remote camp environment. The Core Cutter will be responsible for the preparation, cutting, and sampling of diamond drill core, ensuring a high standard of quality and safety throughout the process. This role is critical in supporting the Company's exploration efforts and requires a strong work ethic and attention to detail.

### **About Us:**

Vizsla Copper Corp. (TSX-V: VCU) is a growth-focused copper and gold exploration company advancing a portfolio of high-potential projects in British Columbia. The Company's exploration efforts are led by its flagship Woodjam Project, with additional work underway at the Redgold, Poplar, and Copperview projects. Vizsla Copper is committed to responsible exploration practices, including strong environmental stewardship and meaningful engagement with local and Indigenous communities. The Company aims to deliver long-term value through systematic exploration and sustainable development.

### **Primary Responsibilities:**

- Cut and sample diamond drill core according to specified procedures.
- Prepare and organize sample bags for transport to the laboratory.
- Maintain accuracy and precision throughout the cutting and sampling process.
- Keep core shack and cutting areas clean, organized, and safe.
- Adhere to all site safety protocols and Company policies.
- Perform routine maintenance of equipment and assist with site upkeep.
- Work collaboratively with geologists and exploration team members to support daily activities.

### **Qualifications:**

- Ability to work in a remote camp setting on a rotational schedule.
- Physically fit and capable of performing demanding physical tasks, including lifting up to 50 lbs regularly and standing for extended periods.
- Strong commitment to health, safety, environmental stewardship, and community engagement.
- Self-motivated with excellent organizational and time management skills.
- Good interpersonal and communication abilities; team-oriented mindset.
- Valid First Aid certification is considered an asset.



- Previous experience with core cutting or fieldwork in the mining/exploration sector is an asset but not required.

**Length of Employment and Rotations:**

This is a short-term rotational position with standard shifts being approximately 15 days on and 13 days off. Travel days are considered workdays. This schedule may be subject to change based on program needs. Length of employment will depend on the length of the exploration program which is planned to be completed late summer 2026. The potential for additional employment beyond the program end date will be discussed with the successful applicant.

**Location:**

This is a field-based position. The work site is located approximately 1 hour south of Houston, BC, along the Morice Forest Service Road. Additional work sites are located near Horsefly BC and Merritt BC. While on site, accommodation and meals will be provided. Reasonable travel costs to and from site will be covered by the employer.

**Compensation:**

The position will be compensated at a daily rate of \$275 based on a 10 hour work day. In accordance with the BC Labour Code, as this position is involved in the collection and processing of geologic samples, overtime rates do not apply.
